When **OKLAHOMA!** opened in CinemaScope at the Hoyts Regent Melbourne on the 11th April 1957 followed by the Hoyts Regent Sydney on the 15th August 1957, there was no cinema in Australia equipped for the 70mm presentation until the opening of **South Pacific** at the Hoyts Mayfair Sydney on the 26th December 1958.

OKLAHOMA! was later reissued, *For the First Time in 70mm*, at the Hoyts Paris Sydney on the 19th November 1961.

Reading through the release dates [bottom page], there was four print moves for <u>Print 1</u> and two print moves for <u>Print 2</u>


