



Village Cinemas was the first exhibitor of a twin cinema in the suburbs of Sydney. Formerly the Vogue Cinema Double Bay, Village Twin Double Bay opened on the 1st December 1972. Their second cinema complex, Village Twin Blacktown, opened in March 1974 and was followed by the three screen Village Cinema City on 25th April 1974.



A COMPLEX of not two, or three, but five cinemas in one is planned for Sydney.

The "Village Chemacity", at 545 George Street, with its first single of three cinemas, is almost ready for opening neat month.

Each cinema (650 sents, 460 sents, 460 sents, and 100 sents, will be small by average standards, but these planned for the second stage will be smaller (250 sents and 200 sents).

"The lifets is that we can stan films in what we call the big house, the 650-

scater," said Village Cla-tma's general manager, Greg Coole.
"When public interest in a film fades, we can move it down through the small-er house.

"Theoretically, one film could eventually play all five theores."
Three premiers will mark the opening.

"Cinema One" "Cinema screen the musical "Mame", "Cinema Two" the new Clint Estwood Porce" "Magnum "Cinema "Malicia" — an Italian film which took more at the box office in listy than tyes "The Godfather".

With three cinemas, and eventually five, Village has ulso decided to enter for appeales of a different kind. The basement will hold a licensed ressurant.

Village Cinema City was located at 545 Street Sydney and was the first key city multiplex in Sydney. The cinema multiplex first 70mm presentations was a film festival which included Hello Dolly, Star, The Great Caruso, The Sound of Music, West Side Story, Sweet Charity and Seven Brides for Seven Brothers.

A noteworthy point for the season of **2001:** A **Space Odyssey** which screened in Cinema 1, due to print damage of the 70mm print, the season was presented partly in 35mm and 70mm.

Village Cinema City was expanded to five screens premiering White Line Fever after the adjoining building on the George Street south west wall was demolished to become two small auditoriums. Cinemas 4 and 5 opened on the 18th March 1976.

A sixth screen was added after the closure of the Village Ascot theatre [05/02/86] within a building structure off the Village Cinema City north eastern wall on Kent Street.

Village Cinema City closed in 2000 and was demolished for the construction of the Meriton Apartments. After the multiplex closure, Village Cinemas and Hoyts Cinemas merged as one exhibitor in the refurbished Hoyts Centre which included an additional four screens after the two large 70mm equipped auditoriums, cinema 3 and 7 were rebuilt to accommodate six 35mm auditoriums. This rebuild was achieved with each of the large auditoriums split in two with the third screen positioned in the area of the original stage / screen area. In 2002 the Greater Union George consisting of six screens and the Hoyts Centre eleven screens merged as a one seventeen screened multiplex renamed George Street Cinemas.




MAROONED was filmed in Panavision [anamorphic] and premiered at Hoyts Mayfair in 70mm Panavision on Wednesday 27th May 1970.

It is worth noting, *MAROONED* which was distributed by Columbia Pictures was the first film from the studio to open in 70mm at a Hoyts key city theatre. Previously, Columbia Pictures films opened at Greater Union which had premiered in 70mm *LAWRENCE OF ARABIA*, *THE LONG SHIPS*, *LORD JIM*, *THE PROFESSIONALS*, *CASINO ROYALE*, *FUNNY GIRL and MACKENNA'S GOLD*.
