To get the maximum out of "Dick Tracy", you need the following:	
-	16 footlamberts on your screen
1 <del></del>	1.85:1 aperture in your projector
	Turn up your sound
For 35mm Prints:	
	If you have STEREO, set your Dolby Fader to no less than "7.5" On a non-dolby system, set the equivalent level (no less than 87dB).
	If you have MONO, raise your sound level the equivalent of 3 dB.
For 70mm Prints:	
	Set your Dolby Fader to no less than "7" (85dB).
	Set your Screen Side Masking to 2.2:1 (to keep left and right side speakers clear and unmuffled).
	If your theater is equipped with Split Surround Stereo, set your Dolby CP 200 Processor to format 43.
	If your theater is equipped with Mono Surround Stereo, set your Dolby CP 200 Processor to format 42.
