Todd Filming 'Days' Scenes for TV-Touting

Behind-the-scenes production activity on Mike Todd's "Around the World in 80 Days" is being filmed for future tv and other promotional uses, Todd disclosed yesterday.

Lou Borzage, inked to direct the 35m documentary filming, returns from Durango, Colo., location and continues shooting at RKO Gower St. lot.

Mike Todd leaves tomorrow for Lawton, Okla., where he'll direct 400 Injuns and a herd of buffalo for "Around the World in 80 Days" sequences.

Michael Todd hops to Lawton, Okla., today to personally handle direction of a second unit on his indie production of "Around the World in 80 Days." Todd will shoot footage of 400 Indians in tribal rites, plus a buffalo stampede sequence. He will complete chore in time to fly to NY for world preem of the first Todd-AO production, "Oklahoma," at Rivoli Theatre Monday night.

Director Michael Anderson meanwhile will wind first unit lensing in Durango, Colo., over weekend and return to Hollywood for resumption of filming Monday at RKO studios.
